## A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

**WHEREAS** there is a pandemic of Coronavirus (also known as Covid-19);

**AND WHEREAS** that disease is affecting the Island and causing serious damage to human health on the Island and the economic well-being of its inhabitants;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, the Governor in Council makes the following proclamation:

### *State of emergency*

A state of emergency continues to exist on the Isle of Man.

### *Duration*

This proclamation comes into operation at 12.01a.m. on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2020 and shall continue in operation until midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2020 unless earlier revoked under section 3(3) of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.
